

Tip for Artists Only

Like every other artist, I need to pack and ship my artwork to various art shows. I have found that what works really well to protect my artwork is a Uline shipping supply product called "bubble bags." You simply slide your artwork into these openend bags made from bubble wrap. A number of various-sized bags are available: www.Uline.com



I then line a cardboard box with the rigid "pink" insulation material that I purchase from Home Depot and place the bubble bagged artwork in between the insulation material. I place this rigid pink insulation material inside the box on both sides, the ends, and the top and bottom of the box.

This eliminates weight and really protects the artwork. It also eliminates all the unwrapping and handling by people who have to unpack the artwork at the show site. From personal experience, unpacking and re-packing artwork that is not sold during a show is the hardest part of the show and causes increased handling of an artwork.



Uline also offers "deluxe artwork shippers" and Fedex now offers good artwork shipping boxes. Another very good box for shipping artwork is the StrongBox[™] by Airfloat Systems.
