# Carolyn Bernard Young At the Weatherford Chamber Breakfast Before Business

Most people that live in Weatherford agree it is a great place to live. A visually stimulating place, with a lovely historic town square, centered around a crown jewel of a courthouse. The old city area offers tree-lined streets with quaint Queen Anne and Victorian houses and the lovely Chandor Gardens. The surrounding open countryside of Parker County, cutting horse country, make this area an artist's landscape paradise. But like most cities, it is the people that make Weatherford great and how they work together that makes it a community. This is why the WAA is a member of the Weatherford Chamber of Commerce, that offers monthly opportunities to meet and network with business and community leaders and exchange ideas. Carolyn Bernard Young, WAA 2<sup>nd</sup> VP of Education, recently attended one of the Chamber offerings, "Breakfast Before Business" where chamber members gathered to hear keynote speaker, Dr. Lloyd Potter, Ph.D., a Demographer for the state of Texas. Carolyn said his presentation was fascinating. Here's some of the things she noted: "His presentation covered the change in population along the I-35 corridor and the Houston area, with some interesting details about Parker County\*:

- Texas grew 16% from 2010-2020 the 3rd greatest growth of any state.
- Texas estimated population was 30,029,572 in 2022.
- The population is growing at the rate of 1290 people per day, but half of that number is born in Texas.
- I-35E & I-35W from Austin/San Antonio to the Metroplex is 87% of the entire population in Texas.
- Parker County was 53rd in the US for growth in 2022.
- Parker County is the 6th largest growth in Texas - 96% of which is from domestic migration; 1.3% for international migration.

\*More information can be found at Demographics.texas.gov." The Weatherford Art Association will continue to grow with our city and offer artistic opportunities for our community, now and in the future.



Judge: Doug Clark is a Texas sculptor and painter with a lifelong love of both art and wildlife. He has taught many students both in public school and adult settings. A 4th generation Texan, Doug has been influenced by his travels through the United States. He is represented in Fredericksburg, Dallas, Santa Fe, Highland Park and in New York. His work has been featured in numerous magazines including local museums and TCU.

Guidelines: All works must be original and created in the last 5 years. Artwork previously entered in WAA Peach Festival Art Shows are Ineligible. WAA reserves the right to refuse any work deemed unsuitable. There will be a 20% commission to WAA on all artwork sold during the show. All works MUST remain for the duration of the show. Max image size 48" in any one direction. Max weight 40 pounds. Adult entries must have d-rings and wires. Student entries must have a rigid backing for hanging.

The Fine Print: Weatherford Art Association, the Doss Heritage and Cultural Center, and its members shall not be held liable for loss or damage to any work of art exhibited. Entrant is responsible for insurance. In addition to entry fees WAA will receive a 20% commission on any work sold during the show. WAA reserves the right of approval for all entries in the show. WAA reserves the right to photograph artwork and use artist or entry information for publicity purposes. In addition, the entrant understands that all artworks left over 30 days following the end of the show becomes the property of WAA and will be sold to assist funding projects.
