Michael said he edits his images down to essentials and then "he leaves some white space in his works to engage the viewer so that they can fill in the blanks themselves." "Three Tenors" and other works by Michael will be on view at the Doss Heritage and Cultural Center during June.

2<sup>nd</sup> Place went to Native American Artist Carolyn Young, for "Defending Friendship". Her acrylic painting depicts a medicine shield with symbols from Choctaw legend. Carolyn explains, "This shield would have been given as a gift and would have been made by a loved one or perhaps a medicine man. The turtle is a storyteller and protector, and the crossed arrows represent friendship." Carolyn's painting will be displayed during June at First Bank Texas in downtown Weatherford.
