David Tripp currently owns The Gallery at Rediands in Palestine. Texas and also displays in Studio 48, 4720 S. Cooper. Arlington. Retiring after three decades in the classroom. David currently enjoys creating watercolors featuring smalltown American sights fading from our landscape, but not our memories. A native Missourian. David grew up in St. Louis and studied art in rural northeast Missouri while earning his Bachelor's degree from Northeast Missouri State University (new Truman State University).

Our watercolor workshop with David Tripp will be March 11, 10am - 4:30pm at the senior center, 1225 Holland Lake Drive. Members' cost will be \$100, non-members \$125. Dan Brown, a beloved local artist, passed away on Sept. 16, 2023, at his Fort Worth home where he lived with his wife of 65 years, Joyce Hawkins Brown.

Remembering a Local Artist

He was born July 26, 1938, in Midland, Texas, In 1943 his family moved to Lubbock, Texas, where Dan grew up. Dan's natural talent for art was first encouraged by his 4th Grade art teacher. He graduated in 1956 from Monterey High School where he served on the annual art staff and took as many art classes as possible. He then attended Texas Tech to study art. After a 15-year career in advertising art, Dan pursued his lifelong dream to earn his living by painting Texas landscapes.

After he retired, Dan moved to Benbrook, TX. For forty years, Dan traveled the Texas Art Circuit selling his original paintings and prints of those paintings. He frequently visited local festivals, and was a regular vendor at such events as the Chappell Hill Bluebonnet Festival, the Weatherford Peach Festival, and the monthly Canton Flea Market. More than 10,000 collectors own his artwork. During those same 40 years, Dan taught art classes in his home studio. Hundreds of people learned to call him teacher and friend.

Dan's favorite subject material for his watercolors was Texas - landscapes, wild flowers, farms, ranches, light houses, canyons, mountains, water and coastlines. For Dan, a painting had to be something that spoke to him with a story to tell. In 2016, Dan was the judge of the Weatherford Art Association's Peach Festival Art Show. He was a good artist, and a wonderful person. He will be missed by all who knew him.
