First place was awarded to artist Cindi Neverdousky for her oil painting “Tomatoes”. A still life rich in color and light, the image was painted so that the subject is captured in about an hour. This method allows the artist to portray the composition in a fresh and spontaneous style. This and other artworks by Cindi will be featured at The Doss Heritage and Culture Center throughout March.

Second place went to Karel Thome for her pastel, “Old Barge”. Brimming with the delicate color and texture that pastel is known for, Karel painted this California Bay scene in plein air and captured the harbor atmosphere perfectly. Weatherford Art Association invites you to view this work, on display in March at First Bank Texas in downtown Weatherford.

Third place honors were awarded to Carmen Davailus for her photograph, “Dahlia-Daze-3”. Carmen tells us this lovely flower was the last dahlia of the year from her garden. The image is printed on wood with a clear brush finish and completed with a custom frame. 

Lisa Frosch is an abstract artist from Midland, Tx. Her award-winning paintings reflect a combination of color, shapes, and movement. Each acrylic, cold wax or encaustic piece of art involves multiple layers of paint and wax that give a sense of depth and mystery. More about Lisa visit her sites:

Join us on **Mon., March 11, 2024 at 6p**, for a complimentary demonstration at the Shanley House Studio, Hosted by Lake Granbury Art Association. Lisa, will demo the process of using cold wax and oil paint on paper. The demo will explain what cold wax medium is and how to use it. She will paint a painting during the time frame while showing various techniques and tools used in cold wax.

On Tue-Wed, March 12-13, 2024 from 9a-4p for the workshop (Members \$160. & Non-Members \$180 / Fee includes \$20. For Cold Wax & Marabu art crayon supplies, which will be collected with registration and paid to Lisa Frosch, the Artist). In an interactive cold wax & oil workshop, participants will explore the basic materials, tools, surfaces, and techniques used in creating cold wax paintings. Students will experience layering, texture and mark-making as well as learn ways to let go of barriers in an effort to be more creative and work more freely.

This class will explore the importance of value and composition. We will use a unified color scheme and texture to create a three dimensional look. Using a limited palette, Kathleen will demonstrate the mixing of triads and explain the importance of grays. Mixtures can be altered by the ratio of warm to cool color that enhances the glow of the final painting. Working at a manageable size with larger shapes will allow students to do three paintings during the 4 day class.

The class starts with a short slide show and Kathleen will discuss choosing reference photos. Each morning and afternoon will begin with a demonstration with plenty of personal one-on-one attention.

Critique will take place at the end of each day. Wet-into-wet, wet-on-dry, glazing techniques and dry brush will be demonstrated and explained.
