

## Fort Worth Society of Watercolor Artists selects Linda Hidalgo as 2023 Artist of the Year

Linda Hidalgo was selected as Artist of the Year of the Fort Worth Society of Watercolor Artists.

Linda is a long-time member of the Weatherford Art Association. Her passion for watercolor painting and learning from other artists led her to also join the Fort Worth SWA, which has more than 400 members.

Linda said she is especially proud of this honor because it is voted on by the SWA members. At each monthly meeting, members bring their best artwork and vote on the winner for the month.

An Artist of the Year is selected from the monthly winners for prize money and recognition.

Her watercolor painting. "Bright Ideas," is drawn from a group of photos Linda took at a Carrie Waller workshop, Back at her studio, Linda studied her photos, recognized the exact composition for her painting and began the painstaking process of painting one light bulb at a time." She credits her artist mentors Waller and Lauren McCracken for her meticulous style of watercolor painting. In her words, "This tells me that all this practice has paid off?"

Hidalgo teaches a free artclass at the Weatherford Senior Center.

This class will explore the intportance of value and composition. We will use a unified ablor scheme and texture to create a three dimensional look. Using a limited paletie, Kathleen will demonstrate the mixing of triads and explain the importance of grays. Mixings can be abroad by the tatio of warm to usel color that cohances the glow of the final painting. Working in a manageable size with larger shapes will allow students to do three paintings during the 4 day class.

The class starts with a short sinde short and Kathleen will discuss choosing reference photos. Each morning and afternion will begin with a demonstration with picuty of personal one-on-one attention.

Critique will take place at the end of each day. Wes-into-wer, wes-on-dry, glazing techniques and dry bresh will be demonstrated and explained.
