Weatherford Needs An Art Center!



May Demo -Amy Glasgow -Monotype & Linocuts



The Weatherford Art Association welcomes Weatherford, Texas artist Amy Glasgow for a demonstration at its May 20th meeting.

Glasgow specializes in oil painting, monotype printmaking, and relief linocut prints. Her art is primarily inspired by nature where she takes photos and sketches to use in the studio as her subjects. During her art career Glasgow has worked in several capacities in the art industry as an educator, gallery sales and assistant director, in art media, and as a full time studio artist. She has both a B.F.A. and M.F.A. in printmaking.

Monotypes begin by painting on a non-absorbent surface, then placing paper or material over the image and applying pressure and transferring the image from the non-absorbent surface to the paper or material by using a printing press or by hand. There are a variety of techniques you can use with this to make a very unique piece of artwork.

Relief Linocut printing is a more modern version of woodcuts using more modern materials. These materials can be linoleum or a material similar to an eraser. You use woodcut tools to carve away anything that is not part of your image, and what you want to

raised. Using a brayer, you roll ink on the raised image and apply pressure with your hand using a barren or with a printing press to transfer the image to paper. You can print multiple prints because the image is fixed.

Glasgow states "I personally love the relief linocut printmaking. It requires more planning ahead and a process to achieve the final product, which almost always has an element of surprise."



The Weatherford Art Association is pleased to announce the winners of Artist of the Month for May. Each month, WAA members can compete for first, second, and third place ribbons and the opportunity to showcase their artwork at local Weatherford banks and The Doss Heritage and Culture Center.

In June all Artist of the Month winners will be eligible to compete for the Artist of the Year award. Images of the previous winners' art will be voted on by online proxy.

First place was awarded to artist Marla Grey Sheft for her watercolor painting "Bluebirds in Spring". Marla's style is very unique with detailed anatomically correct animals amid their natural surroundings. A lifelong artist she taught herself watercolors during recovery from cancer. All of her paintings have small creatures hidden in them such as the ants in this one and her trademark ladybug. This and other artworks by Marla will be featured at The Doss Heritage and Culture Center throughout May.

Second place went to Jill Harper for her watercolor painting "Jars". Jill took the photo of the vibrant vases on a trip to Disneyworld and knew she had to create it in a watercolor work. 



I also recently completed a Barn Owl in Acrylic.







INTRODUCTION TO STILL LIFE WORKSHOP

Paula has been painting and teaching for over 50 years. She paints in oil, watercolor, pastel and acrylic and on porcelain with overglaze pigments.

WHAT: This class is designed to teach about arrangement, design, color in a still life.

Paula will have handouts for the students with a lesson on still life painting.

Students will make simplified arrangements of still life with one special object they bring to class and flowers and fruit provided by the teacher. A small value sketch will be made of the arrangement at their table; Paula will furnish the Bristol for the sketch. Student may use a water base pen (TOMBOW) or pencil for the sketch. Bring mat with 4X6 or 5X7 opening.

Students may paint in their chosen media, watercolor, oil, acrylic, oil, overglaze paints. Bring supplies for your chosen medium including paper and or canvas (smaller size canvas and paper, 8X10 to 11X14 pleae, your chosen piece to add to still life, a sack lunch and drink, anything else you think you will need.


