Categories

- All Artwork will be judged in one category.

Qualifications of Art

- Open Show for adults 18 years or older.
- Artworks must NOT have been entered in any previous WAA Western Art Show.
- All artworks must be dry, with pastels fixed.
- Artwork should be an original design & concept, created independently within the last 3 years. No giclee's.
- D-rings must be attached for hanging. If gallery wrapped, edges must be painted. 3-D pedestals will be provided.
- Work must remain in gallery for entire show.
- Digital compositions using AI Image Generator Software are not allowed.

Diana is the Associate Executive Director for the National Cowgirl Museum and Hall of Fame. Dr. Vela has served as a judge for numerous art shows including the AQHA and the Cowgirl Artists of America. She has created exhibitions, one of which was The Cowgirl who Became a Justice. Dr. Vela has served as a principal investigator, researcher and curator for Soldaderas to Amazonas, an exhibition that ties back to centuries to her love of Texas in the 1700's when her ancestors received a Spanish land Grant in the Rio Grande Valley.
