DONNY SPENCER


The Weatherford Art Association welcomes Texas artist Donny Spencer for a demonstration at its August ¬26th meeting from 6-7:45 p.m., at the Senior Center, 1225 Holland Lake Drive in Weatherford.

Spencer is a full-time pencil/graphite artist. He grew up in New Mexico where he drew desert landscapes and wildlife as a hobby. Donny continued to draw throughout his school years. When he finished college he moved to Texas, where he worked and continued creating artwork as a hobby. In 2017 Donny began taking on commissions for extra income and became busy enough to go full time two years ago. Donny currently travels around art festivals, local pop ups, and many other art events showcasing his work.

Artist Statement: My art encourages the viewer to observe the natural world around them and to pay attention to its story. To remember, with reverence, the beautiful details that are all around.

Spencer works primarily in graphite and prisma color pencil in a realism technique. For the demonstration, he will go over shading, blending, and how to add texture.

ELECTION TIME!

Election of Officers for WAA

This shall serve as notice of the upcoming election. We will vote in the September meeting and the new slate of officers will begin October 1 as stated in our by-laws. Nomination may be made from the floor in August.







Justin grew up in Farmers Branch, Texas and studied at the University of North Texas. He earned his BFA focusing primarily on Studio Drawing and Painting. His work focuses on spaces that are left as they are, weathered and abandoned fragments of a time once lived. His paintings have been exhibited in Dallas/Fort Worth and have been featured in publications such as Studio Visit Magazine and Friend of the Artists.




Downsizing is HARD!


