Carol Acedo was born in Louisville, Kentucky and moved to get North Carolina as a teenager, where she later attended NC State no University and earned a degree in Industrial Design. She has now settled in Ft. Worth, Texas, and specializes in designing lighting M fixtures for varous manufacturers. Her creative ambitions carry la over to her love of art that she has expressed throughout her ar career. M

Carol is best known for her unique method of painting in which she applies acrylic paint onto raw canvas that is prepared with a clear gesso. This method produces a soft, light absorbing, matte surface not common to most paintings.

Most of her works are monochromatic while others have color layered on top of a monochromatic underpainting. Animals, architecture, and musicians are common subjects in her artwork. Many of her portraits of Jazz/Blues Musicians and other subjects can be found in coffee shops and private collections all around the country. 



Jim Stewart was a retired architectural designer in the commercial real estate development business who has had a passion for painting since the late 1950's. A native born Texan from Lubbock James graduated from McMurray University as an art major and became a muralist, 'plein air 'and studio painter working in all mediums. His mural 'Texas Under Six Flags still remains in the J. Rollins Library at McMurry University.

After retirement, Jim kept his interest in painting by producing commission works and golf related illustrations which took a back seat to his many sports interests. In addition to being a competitive golfer




Longtime member of several local art associations, James (Jim) Stewart passed away on August 29th,2024.

he reignited his passion for painting in 2010 and received Best of Show in his first Juried event. He was a traditional "Texas Western Landscape Painter" who is rigid in conforming to the 'fundamental principles of art' and believes the success of a painting is found in its composition, accuracy, dramatic impact, collective presentation and most importantly public appreciation. Jim is survived by his wife, Cheryl, his daughters, Amanda Henry of Lewisville, Texas, Tina Newton of Trophy Club, Texas and his son, Shea Stewart of Argyle, Texas. 

#### Painting on Silk Scarves

Silk Scarf Workshop Artist and Teacher



Betsy learned to love working with silk and silk dyes about 6 years ago. "I was at a church camp retreat with my kids and grandkids. I went to this little elective class that was offered on making silk scaves. It took me about 3 minutes, and I was hooked! Even though it is not an easy task! You must source your silks and supplies, there are racks that must be assembled, silk must be treated, (at every step.) and then a good design-and colors chosen. Then you start on a one-of-a-kind creation!"

In my workshop I have done all of that prep for you! I will have white scarves, dyes and all the tools. You can copy from my sources or bring your own design.

We will make 2 scarves in our class, using 2 different techniques. You can wear them or put them proudly on display! We will have fan and relax and enjoy this ancient art!

Betsy's silk has been featured on a billboard in North Richland Hills, and her scarves were part of a 2 woman show earlier this year called "Betsy x 2". She has been a proud Tag member since 2018 and participated in numerous shows. She has sold her silks locally and internationally.

#### Painting on a Gessoed Surface





Robyn will be demonstrating her methods for using watercolor on paper prepared with acrylic gesso. Painting this way gives the artist lats of splishy splashy play time because it is so easy to remove paint from the gessoed surface later. This gives plenty of time to develop the image without worrying about the painting drying too quickly.

A former oil painter, Robyn became interested in the transparent layering possible with watercolor, a medium which often rewards artists who carefully plan those layers. During the learning process, she discovered that what she liked even more was the fluid blending and all the happy occidents that occur. This led her to her current way of working, which now also often incorporates other watermedia such as gouache, ink, and acrylic.

Robyn's work has been accepted in many juried shows and she has won several awards, including the "Best of Show" in the 2018 Soutwestern Watercolor Society show. One of her paintings was selected for installation as a mural in downtown Dallas, where it was on display for the year 2020. More of her work can be seen at https://www.robynjorde.com.
