





The Weatherford Art Association is pleased to announce the winners of Artist of the Month for October. Each month, WAA members can compete for first, second, and third place ribbons and the opportunity to showcase their artwork at local Weatherford banks and The Doss Heritage and Culture Center.

Artist of the Month first place winners are eligible to compete for the Artist of the Year award which is voted on by online proxy every June.

First place was awarded to artist Marla Sheft with her acrylic painting "The Garlic". This painting inspired by Marla's love of garlic, was a fun unique creative departure from her usual animal paintings, she hopes it puts a smile on the viewers face. This and other artworks by Marla will be featured at The Doss Heritage and Culture Center throughout October.

Second place went to Jerry Shidal with his 3D sculpture "The Casa". Jerry became fascinated with modeling a few years ago, when he realized that it was possible to create 3-D models with commonly available household items like cardboard, foam, popsicle sticks, paint, and glue. Jerry had no previous experience with model-making but found how-to videos on the internet that made the process look interesting and easy. Last year one of his models of the Central Christian Church in Weatherford sold for \$700 at the Christmas fund-raising auction. In this piece Jerry particularly enjoys the adobe-looking walls and the Spanish tile roof. He hopes it might inspire other model makers to give it a try. Jerry's model was a little too big to display at the First Bank Texas in Weatherford, so he has substituted a 3-D shadowbox of a Spanish Doorway. It will be on display there for the month of October.

Third place honors were awarded to Barbara Carey with her watercolor "The Birds". This piece was inspired by a pair of visiting Painted Buntings in Barbara's backyard. View Barbara's art in October, at the Fort Worth Community Credit Union on South Main Street in Weatherford.





ELIGIBILITY & ARTWORK REQUIREMENTS

- Open to all current SWA Members in good standing.
 If joining SWA to participate in this exhibition, dues must be paid prior to entry deadline. The SWA yearly calendar runs from January thru December.
- 2. Artists may enter up to three (3) paintings in each exhibition. Only one painting per artist may be accepted into each show.
- All paintings must have been completed in the last 3 years, and not shown in any previous SWA exhibitions.
- 4. Work may include traditional watercolor, gouache, acrylic, ink, watercolor pencil/stick/crayon, egg tempera, casein, collage with >80% watermedia on watermedia-paper. Acceptable substrate/surface includes watercolor paper, Yupo, canvas, rice paper, watercolor panel/board and gesso-surface.
- 5. Paintings on canvas must be gallery-wrapped with all edges finished. (Frame optional)
- All other paintings must be framed with clear plexiglass or similar product (no glass), varnished or fixatives.
 - Frame width 2" maximum on each side. Frames can

The juror will be instructed to choose the Best of Show painting from the 1st place painting from either member group. This will eliminate a 1st place in that member group but will boost the monetary value originally assigned to that place. Additionally, any Signature Status member who has never been chosen by a juror for an award is eligible for a President's Award.

The Small Works Exhibition will award 1°, 2° & 3° place and will not count towards signature status.

Submission to the SWA juried exhibition constitutes an agreement on the part of the entrant to the conditions set forth in this prospectus. Every precaution will be taken in handling artwork. SWA, Box and Ship or the The REC of Grapevine is not responsible for loss or damage to any work of art. Artists are responsible for loss/damage to any work, and for insurance of paintings to, from, and during the exhibit. Any artwork arriving without proper payment will be held until fees are paid. If, after 30 days, the artist has not provided payment, the artwork in question will become the property of SWA. If it is an award-winning piece, those payments will be deducted from the award before the painting is returned.


