Jerry Shidal will be demonstrating how to craft 3-D objects as art pieces. In WAA's October 2024 Artist of the Month competition second place went to Jerry Shidal with his 3D sculpture called "The Casa". Jerry became fascinated with modeling a few years ago, when he realized that it was possible to create 3-D models with commonly available household items like cardboard, foam, popsicle sticks, paint, and glue. Jerry had no previous experience with model-making but found how-to videos on the internet that made the process look interesting and easy. Last year one of his models of the Central Christian Church in Weatherford sold for \$700 at the Christmas fund-raising auction. In this piece Jerry particularly enjoys the adobe-looking walls and the Spanish tile roof. He hopes it might inspire other model makers to give it a try.
