PARKER COUNTY STUDENT ART SHOW

The 2026 Parker County Student Art Show for grades 6-12 will be held virtually this year. This show is an annual event sponsored by the Weatherford Art Association to showcase artworks from Parker County art students as part of the NAEA Youth Art Month celebration held each March. The show is open to **ALL** art students in Parker County. Entries are submitted through the

on-campus art teacher. **ELIGIBLE ARTWORKS MUST HAVE BEEN CREATED BETWEEN SUMMER OF 2025 AND SPRING 2026. STUDENTS MUST BE PASSING ALL SUBJECTS TO ENTER.**

Each entry is \$1, and this goes back to the students as monetary awards.

CATERGORIES:

Art 1 -grades 6-7-8

Art 1 -grades 9-12

Art 2 – grades 7-8

Art 2 -grades 9-12

Art 3-4-Advanced Placement

Sculpture – all grades

AWARDS

Monetary prizes and ribbons will be awarded to the top 3 winners in each category.

Honorable mentions will receive ribbons only.

The overall Best of Show will be awarded a monetary prize and a ribbon.

PCSAS ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- **TO ENTER** -Photograph each entry, save and label with student name, media category,

and place in appropriate category folder. Please take care to send a quality photograph.

- **Ex.** MarySmith, art 1-9-12-media-school-teacher.
- Share to google docs. This seems to work the best.
- PLEASE remember to **share with me** before spring break or I cannot open.
- Email a master list of student entries with names, titles and categories to kathycunning@sbcglobal.net
- Payment of \$1 per entry can be made online at Weatherfordart.com under donations (please specify PCSAS), or by check made payable to Weatherford Art and mailed to Kathy Cunning WAA, 105 Crown Rd, Weatherford, TX 76087
- Teachers may enter **10 art works** in each category.

DEADLINES

- March 13 (Friday) All entries due before spring break
- March 25-27 – teachers notified of winners
- March 30 week – all prizes and awards delivered to schools. A Power Point of winning entries will be shared on Weatherford Art's FB page, on Google doc, and on the WAA's webpage at weatherfordart.com.
- In addition to monetary prizes (all entry fees go back to the students), WAA members donate art materials throughout the year, and these prizes are awarded to students whose names are drawn at randomly.
