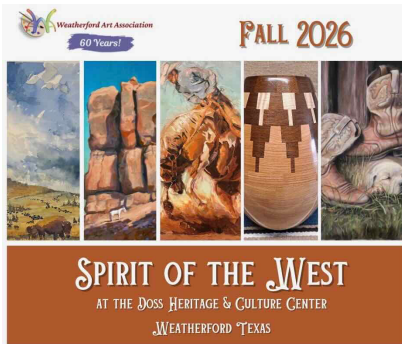

Qualifications of Art

- Open Show for adults 18 years or older.
- Artworks must NOT have been entered in any previous WAA Western Art Show.
- All artworks must be dry, with pastels fixed.
- Artwork should be an original design & concept, created independently within the last 3 years. No giclee's.
- D-rings must be attached for hanging. If gallery wrapped, edges must be painted. 3-D pedestals will be provided.
- Work must remain in gallery for entire show.
- Digital compositions using any AI Image Generator Software on any part of the artwork is ineligible.

Judge Megan Wimberley

From the moment Megan Wimberley could cling to a saddle horn, legs barely long enough to sit a horse, she was in love. Her fascination with the wild and domestic animals of the American West has dominated much of her life. Through her work, Wimberley contemplates our connection to, and partnerships with, the animals around us.

She is the founder of Cowgirl Artists of America, which strives to increase opportunities and recognition for female artists and makers working in the western genre. Wimberley's work has been exhibited in the Mountain Oyster Show, Cowgirl Up! at Sigler Western Museum, The Cowgirl Gathering, and Women's Work at the A.R. Mitchell Museum of Western Art, among others.

Wimberley received a BA in Fine arts from Wayland Baptist University and an MA in Art Education from Boston University.
